

**Onondaga, Onondaga Co. NY
(South Onondaga)**

Be it remembered that at a meeting of the male members of the Universalist society held at the school house near the meeting house in South Onondaga in the town of Onondaga on the 1st day of September 1833 pursuant to public notice and according to the statute incorporating religious societies in such case made and provided[,] Jacob Chase Jr. and John F. Clark were duly nominated and elected to preside at said meeting and to certify and return the proceedings thereof the clerk of said county[,] that at said meeting it was unanimously resolved and agreed that said Society should forever thereafter be known and called by the name and title of the first Universalist Society in the town of Onondaga[,] that the following persons were then and there duly elected Trustees of said Society viz: John Case, John Clark and Abner Chapman and that said Trustees and their successors shall forever hereafter be known and distinguished by the name and title of "The Trustees of the first Universalist Society in the town of Onondaga."
