

Salisbury, Herkimer Co. NY

At a meeting legally notified of a number of the inhabitants of the Town of Salisbury at the house of Abial Pratt, Nathaniel Dibell was called to the chair and Thaddeus Loomis was appointed secretary. After the object of the meeting was made known the following resolutions were adopted 1) Resolved that we proceed to organize a religious Society according to law under the style and like of the first Universalist Society in Salisbury 2) Resolved that we appoint three Trustees to take charge of the property of the said society as the law directs 3) Resolved that Silas Thompson and Thaddeus Munson serve as tellers of this meeting to receive the ballots for Trustees and to decide and certify as the law directs. We the undersigned inspectors or tellers do hereby certify that on canvassing the ballots that Abiel Pratt, Samuel Smith and Horace Loomis had the greatest number of votes and are duly elected Trustees. We further certify that in drawing in our presence Samuel Smith drew for one year[,] Abial Pratt for two years and Horace Loomis for three years. Done at Salisbury December 25th 1830[.] Witness our hands and seals—

On this 25th day of December 1830 the above named Silas Thompson & Thaddeus Munson both to me personally known acknowledged the above certificate & signatures to be their free and voluntary acts[.] I do therefore allow the same to be recorded.
