

**Virgil, Cortland Co. NY  
(Harford\*)**

Cortland County

Be it remembered that at a meeting of the male members of the Universalist Society held at the house of Gordon Burlingame in the town of Virgil on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 1833 pursuant to public notice & according to statute incorporating and regulating religious societies in such case made and provided[,] Putman Dewolf and Nathan Heaton were duly nominated and elected to preside at said meeting and to certify and return the proceedings thereof to the Clerk of said county[;] That at said meeting it was unanimously resolved and agreed that said Society should forever hereafter be known and designated by the name & title of the Harford Universalist Society[;] That the following persons were then & there duly elected Trustees of said Society to wit: Josiah Hart[,] Heman Daniels and Nathan Heaton[,] and that said Trustees and their successors shall forever hereafter be known and called by the name & title of the Trustees of the Harford Universalist Society.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year first above written.
