We the undersigned, two of the members of the Society hereafter mentioned hereby certify that on the ninth day of October 1880 at a meeting of the persons of full age belonging to the Universalist Congregation at Hights Corners, town of Westfield, Chautauqua Co. N.Y. for the purpose of incorporating the same, which meeting was held at Hights Corners in the house where they stately assemble for Divine Worship. And pursuant to notice duly given upon the 19th day of September and the 3rd day of October at the stated meetings of said congregation for Public Worship, by Rev. J. W. Payson, the Minister of said congregation, the undersigned were nominated by a majority of the members present as returning officers and that said members did then and there elect by plurality of voices Mr. Able Holcomb, Mrs. F. Hill and Mr. Wilder Rexford as Trustees of the said Society. And the said persons did then and there also determine by the like plurality of voices that the said Trustees and their successors should forever hereafter be called and known by the name or title of the Trustees of the Universalist Society of Hights Corners.
