Gooding and Arunah Jones (two of the members of said society) were chosen by the members present to receive the votes of the electors, [and] be the judges of the qualifications of the electors and the officers to return the names of the persons elected to serve as Trustees for the said society. Therefore we further certify that at the said meeting, Nathaniel Fisher, Benjamin Simmons, and Anson Packard, of Bristol aforesaid, were duly elected Trustees to be called and known (they and their successors in office) by the name or title of the Trustees of the first Universalist Society in Bristol. Given under our hands and seals this thirteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.
