We the undersigned two of the members of the congregation hereinafter mentioned, do certify that on the thirty first day of July one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, the male persons of full age belonging to a congregation in which divine worship is celebrated according to the rites of the Universalist Church and not already incorporated met at the place of public worship heretofore occupied by the said congregation near the corner of Franklin and Clinton streets at Green Point in the City of Brooklyn in said county for the purpose of incorporating themselves and did then and there elect by plurality of voices James English    Allen W. Thompson    James Snow    Samuel B. Arnold    William W. Finehout    James J. Jones    Josiah Palmer as trustees of the said congregation or society[.] And the said persons did then and there also determine by the like plurality of voices that the said trustees and their successors should forever hereafter be known and called by the name or title of the Trustees of the Third Universalist Society of Brooklyn[.] In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this twenty first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.
