Notice having been given by the minister of the first Universalist Society of East Bloomfield on two Sabbaths of the stated meetings of said society viz: on the thirtieth day of October ultimo and on the thirteenth day of November instant that a meeting of said society would be held on the fifteenth day of November present at 7 o'clock P.M. at the brick school house on the public square in East Bloomfield (it being the stated place of meetings of said society) for the purpose of legally electing trustees of the said society [a] meeting was accordingly held for that purpose. There being no Elders or church wardens the subscribers were nominated by a majority of the members present to preside at such Election, receive the votes of the Electors[,] judge of the qualification of such electors and to return the names of the persons who should by plurality of votes be elected to serve as Trustees of said society, and do certify that Darius Carter, Azariah Bickford, Silas Harris, Frederick Boughton, Silas Pierce and Harlow Munson were unanimously elected Trustees and that the name or title by which said society wishes to be known and distinguished as that of "The First Universalist Society of East Bloomfield." Given under our hands and seals at Bloomfield this fifteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one.
