Y., which said meeting was for the purpose of incorporating said Church Society in said Village of Dolgeville in the Church where they statedly assembled for divine worship, and which said meeting was held pursuant to a notice duly given upon the 1st day of November, 1892 and 8th day of November, 1892, at stated meetings of said congregation for public worship by the Rev. Richard E. Sykes, Pastor of said Church, we, the undersigned, were nominated by a majority of the members present as a Committee to recommend officers to be elected by said society and preside over said election, and that said male members did then and there, by a majority of voices, elect Wheeler Knapp, Eli F.
