Be it remembered that at a meeting of the male members of the Court Street Church Association held at the Universalist Church in the fourth ward of the city of Rochester N. York on the 30 day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one pursuant to publick [sic] notice and according to the statute incorporating and regulating religious societies in such case made and provided[,] Silas Pierce was duly nominated and elected as Moderator and George H. Roberts as clerk at said meeting and Joseph Wood and Schuyler Moses was [sic] duly nominated and elected to certify and return the proceedings thereof to the clerk of said county[,] that at said meeting it was unanimously resolved and agreed that said association should forever hereafter be known and distinguished by the name and title of the Court Street Church Association[,] that the following persons were then and there duly elected Trustees of said Court Street Church Association to wit Elizer [Eleazer] Conkey for one year[,] Schuyler Moses for two years and George H. Roberts for three years[,] and that the said Trustees and their successors in office shall forever hereafter be known and called by the name and title of the Trustees of the Court Street Church Association.
