Death of a Former University Student

Prof. H. P. Forbes started on Wednesday of last week to conduct the funeral services of Rev. Orlando A. Rounds, a classmate in the University, who died at the home of his wife's parents, at Waterford, Maine, Tuesday, Dec. 27, of bronchial consumption. Mr. Rounds was graduated from the Theological School in 1873. He was for some years pastor of the Universalist church at Potsdam, and had a wide circle of friends in the county. From Potsdam he accepted a call to the Church of the Reconciliation at Utica, where he was pastor for five years, ending the 1st of September last. In the hope of benefitting his health he spent a portion of last winter at Thomasville, Georgia. Early last fall he went to California, first seeking renewed strength at Pasadena, thence going to Santa Monica [Monica] "by the sea." He, however, received no benefit and about the first of December returned east to die. Mr. Rounds was a man of good attainments and agreeable qualities, making many friends wherever he went. A father, mother, and other relatives at Sacket's Harbor and a wife and three children mourn their great loss.
