HARRY C. ARNOLD

Middleville—Harry C. Arnold, 82, Town of Fairfield, who resided on the Middleville-Little Falls Road, died Nov. 21, 1944, in the Little Falls Hospital.

He was born in the Town of Fairfield, son of Daniel and Cordelia Arnold. He had been engaged in farming for the past 34 years. He was the last surviving member of the Morehouse Lake Cub.

Mr. Arnold was president of the Grange Mercantile Association, Little Falls. He was superintendent of the Herkimer County Home from 1906 to 1909.

On Sept. 18, 1893, he married Charlotte Fenner, who survives, with two daughters, Gladys, Amsterdam, and Mrs. Elmer Bergstrom, Rome; and two sons, Ralph, at home, and Thomas, Herkimer.

Mr. Arnold attended the Universalist Church. The funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Friday from the home, the Rev. Howard C. Gilman, Little Falls, officiating. Burial will be in Middleville.
