WINFIELD SCOTT LULL

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon of last week at 2 o'clock at the home for Winfield Scott Lull, who died Tuesday morning at 6:30 o'clock at his home in Morris from the infirmities of age. The Rev. Dr. C. E. Vermilyea officiated and burial was in Hillington cemetery.

Mr. Lull, who had been ill about three weeks, was born April 28, 1863 at Morris, the son of Almon and Pamela Lull. He married Miss Hattie Winifred Lull of Morris, November 11, 1891.

He is survived by a son, Leland E. Lull of Morris; two grandchildren, Betty Jane and Robert Stewart Lull of Morris; two brothers, Clarence E. Lull of Morris and Frank Lull of Los Angeles, Cal., as well as several nieces and nephews.

He was a member of the Universalist church and the Tienderrah Masonic lodge at Morris. He was a farmer, and for the past twenty years had been employed by Dr. H. W. Naylor of Morris.
