Death of Rev. Thomas Borden

The Leader of January 15, contains a notice of the death of Rev. Thomas Borden, at one time pastor of the Universalist church at this place. He died at the Odd Fellows home in Concord, N. H., November 23, 1909, aged 89 years. In his younger days he held pastorates in some of the large churches of the denomination, and even in his later years and in feeble health, while at Sherman, his sermons were of a high order, and his zeal and christian spirit were always a characteristic of his life. His wife died soon after they left Sherman, and failing health compelled him to give up work. He lived for a time with his daughter at Manchester, N.H., but for a few years has been well cared for at the Home where he died.
