Canton, Jan. 4, 1887.

The Rev. Geo. E. Forbes, pastor of the Universalist church here, died at 4 p. m. Jan. 3rd at the residence of his wife's parents in Potsdam, whither he had gone during the Holidays on a visit. While there he was taken sick with acute bronchitis, and lingered but a few days after first attack.

His funeral will take place Thursday, Jan. 6th at 9:30 a. m. at Universalist church. Drs. Atwood and Gaines are expected to officiate, after which the remains will be conveyed to West Sumner, Me., for interment.

Canton, Jan. 10, 1887.

The funeral services of Rev. George E. Forbes, pastor of the Universalist Society, were held in the church Jan. 6, when remarks were made by Rev. Drs. Lee, Atwood and Gaines. His body, accompanied by his brother, Prof. Henry P. Forbes, of the Theological School, was conveyed to West Sumner, Me., and placed by the side of his first wife. He leaves a wife and boy two years old. His age was 41 years.
