A VETERAN TEACHER GONE Miss Loretta Eames of Lee Centre Dies in St. Louis, Mo.

LEE CENTER, Nov. 30—Miss Loretta Eames, who went from this village Nov. 11 to spend the winter with her brother, Henry Eames, who resides in that place, died suddenly on Thursday at 6:30 p.m. with heart difficulty, aged 61 years. The deceased was born in this town and had taught school since the age of 15. With the exception of five years which he taught in Auburn, Mich., she has followed her profession in this and adjoining towns. She conducted the primary department of the Union Free School in this village about 45 terms and was considered one of the best teachers of primary pupils in the state. She leaves two brothers, Clayton, who resides in Cortland, and Henry of St. Louis, and one sister, Mrs. Orvil Potter of Lee Centre, and many friends and acquaintances who will mourn her death.
