Florence J. Edwards

Corfu, Jan. 3.—Miss Florence J. Edwards, daughter of the late William D. and Rose King Edwards of Corfu, died early New Year's morning in Buffalo General Hospital after a long illness with diabetes.

Miss Edwards was born in Salamanca, July 12, 1873, and came to Corfu at about the age of 15 where her father opened a drug store.

She was a member of the former Universalist Church of Corfu and the Eastern Star Lodge of Little Valley. She was a graduate of Corfu High School class of 1890.

She had been employed in the county clerk's office of Little Valley, Harrison real estate office in Buffalo and the Rich insurance office in Gowanda.

Surviving are four cousins, Mrs. Claude L. Wilson of Little Valley, Frank K. Tubbs of Orchard Park, Ralph K. Darrow of Chicago and Mrs. Hattie T. Edwards of Buffalo, also a brother-in-law, Daniel A. Schelt of Corfu.

Funeral services were held this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home of Mrs. Edwards at No. 540 Breckenridge street, Buffalo. The Rev. Harry M. Wright of Bristol officiated and interment was made in Evergreen Cemetery, Corfu.
