MRS. SARAH ALLEN EDWARDS

Mrs. Sarah Allen Edwards, widow of the late Orville A. Edwards, died at her home in Morris village, Saturday morning, Nov. 12th. She had been afflicted with heart trouble for some time and had been confined to her bed for two weeks.

Sarah Allen was born in Sauquoit, N. Y. on October 9th, 1848, a daughter of Benjamin and Olive Braddock Allen. When about two years of age she moved with her parents to Dimmock Hollow where she resided until her marriage to Orville A. Edwards on November 6, 1867. Mr. Edwards, a veteran of the Civil War, died October 12, 1920. With the exception of one year, during which they lived in South New Berlin, their entire married life was spent in Morris, where Mr. Edwards was, for many years, engaged in the cooper business. Mrs. Edwards was a devoted member of the Universalist church in Morris. She was beloved by all who knew her.

The surviving relatives are a daughter, Mrs. Merton R. Porter of Schenectady; three grand children, Ralph F. Porter of Morris, Alice O. and Robert M. of Schenectady; a brother, William Allen of Morris and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral was held at her late home on Monday at 2 p.m. Her pastor, Rev. F. G. Leonard officiated. Interment was made in Hillington cemetery, Morris.
