DE ETTE D. ELLISON Esteemed Resident Who Died This Morning

Miss De Ette D. Ellison, a well known and highly respected resident of this city, died in the Homeopathic Hospital shortly after 7 o'clock this morning. For the past eight weeks she had been in poor health and for the past six weeks had been confined to her bed. Her health became guite alarming and last Wednesday afternoon she was removed to the hospital with the hope that an operation would benefit her health. She was operated upon the day following and the operation was very successful. She rallied till Saturday morning, when a change for the worse came, and since that time her health had been gradually declining until her death this morning. Miss Ellison was the daughter of Jacob, Sr. and Della Richardson Ellison. She was born in Middleville September 30, 1834. Her preliminary education was acquired in the public schools in her native village and later she entered Fairfield Seminary, where her education was completed. Twenty-two years ago last fall she made her home with her brother, H. D. Ellison, at 8 Scott street. Miss Ellison was a member of the [Universalist] Church of the Reconciliation and always took a deep interest in matters pertaining to the welfare of the congregation until failing health compelled her to retire. Besides her brother, H. D. Ellison, she is survived by a niece, Mrs. H. A. Harrison, both of this city.
