HENRY D. ELLISON

Well known Resident Died This Morning In This City.

Henry Duane Ellison died early this morning at his home, 8 Scott street. He had been confined to the house for about three months, but his condition was not considered serious until within a couple days. He was born near Middleville, Herkimer County, in 1833, living there until 1880, when he removed to his late home on Scott street, where he died. In 1858 he was married to Elnora J. Arnold, who died in 1888.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Herbert A. Harrison of Utica, and an adopted son, Peter S. Richardson of East Orange, N. J., and two grandsons, Glenn Ellison Richardson and Thomas Duane Harrison. He also leaves an uncle, Warren W. Richardson of West Schuyler, aged 86 years.

He was a member of Newport Lodge, F. & A.M.

As a young man he was interested in the cheese buying business for some years and was also interested in the manufacture of Yale locks, which were then made at Newport. Since coming to Utica he had not been engaged in active business.

The remains will be sent to Middleville for interment by Undertakers Lankton & White, where the funeral will be held.
