JESSE J. ELLSWORTH

Jesse J. Ellsworth, aged 90, of Schuyler Lake, died Friday in the Clark Nursing Home in Richfield Springs, after a long illness.

He was born December 13, 1868, in the Town of Otsego, the son of Sylvester and Minerva (Perkins) Ellsworth, and attended school in the Town of Otsego. He married Ann McDonough of Fly Creek in 1893 in Cooperstown. They lived in Oaksville and later in Schuyler Lake where Mr. Ellsworth conducted a dairy farm until his retirement ten years ago.

He attended the Universalist Church and had been a Mason for 63 years, being a member of Schuyler Lake Masonic Lodge 162, F. & A.M., Otsego Commandery in Cooperstown, and Ziyara Temple Shrine in Utica.

Surviving are two sons, Warren R. Ellsworth of Schuyler Lake and Elmer J. Ellsworth of Harrisburg, Pa.; a daughter, Mrs. James Pepper of Utica; a brother, Ralph W. Ellsworth, and two sisters, Mrs. Harry Fowler and Mrs. Henry Patrick, all of Cooperstown; five grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. on Sunday in Richfield Springs, with the Rev. George C. Boorn, retired Universalist minister of Cooperstown, officiating. Burial will be later in Fly Creek Cemetery. Schuyler Lake Lodge conducted Masonic rites at 7:30 p.m. on Saturday in Richfield Springs.
