G. S. Eveleth, Little Falls Doctor, Dies

LITTLE FALLS—Dr. George S. Eveleth, 92, who practiced medicine here for more than 61 years, died July 22, 1957, at his home in Newport, N.H.

He was born Jan. 3, 1865, in Bethel, Me., son of Ezekiel and Augusta Hammond Eveleth. He graduated from Tufts College in 1885 and from Belleview Medical College, New York, March 12, 1888, with a doctor of medicine degree.

After graduating, he practiced in Glendale, Calif., for a short time, returning to the East in the spring of 1892 to serve as resident physician at Healing Springs, Bath County, Va.

Dr. Eveleth came to Little Falls in December, 1892, and remained here until 1954 when he left to make his home in Newport.

In 1905, he was awarded an honorary master of arts degree from Tufts.

He married Annie Stimson in California. She died in 1939. He leaves a son, George S. Eveleth, Jr., of Rye; a daughter, Mrs. Emily E. Snyder, Newport, a former teacher at Little Falls High School; four grandsons, four great grandchildren.

The private funeral will be today from the Newton-Bartlett Funeral Home in Newport, N.H. Burial will be Friday in Auburn, Me.
