MRS. JESSIE EVINGER DIES IN MIDDLEPORT
Chief Postoffice Clerk Had Been Ill Long Time—Funeral to Be Held Monday

MIDDLEPORT, May 28—Mrs. Jessie Castle Evinger, 63, chief clerk in the Middleport postoffice and a lifelong resident of this village, died at her home on Vernon street Friday afternoon, of a heart affliction from which she had been a long time sufferer. She had recently returned from the Medina Memorial hospital where she had been confined for some time.

Mrs. Evinger had been employed in the Middleport postoffice for 37 years, was a past matron of Princess chapter 405, O.E.S., and a member of the Middleport Universalist church and its Women's Auxiliary.

She was the daughter of the late Amos and Annie Castle. One brother, Harry Castle, of Rochester, survive[s].

Rites will be conducted Monday afternoon at 3:30 in the home, the Rev. Clifford Stetson of the Middleport Universalist church officiating. Burial will be in Hartland Central cemetery.
