MARVIN GRAVES AGED 80 YEARS Resident of North Hill Died at Home of Son Following an Attack of Grip, Saturday, July 7th—Funeral Thursday

Death claimed Martin Graves, aged 80 years, a resident of North Hill, Saturday, July 9, 1928.
