Rites Held for H. D. MacArthur

Harold D. MacArthur, 79, formerly of Nunda, died at his home on Forest road, Knapp Creek, Friday, Feb. 24, 1967.

A native of Nunda, he attended school here and was graduated from Pratt Institute in Brooklyn in 1909. He retired in 1957 as Nunda Village Police Chief after 16 years of service. He was a member of the [former] Nunda Universalist church and of Hope Hose Co. No. 4 of Nunda.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Frances Dolan MacArthur; a son, Eugene D. of Knapp Creek; a grandson and several cousins.

The funeral and committal were held at the Duryea Funeral Home Monday, Dr. Irwin W. Underhill, pastor of the Nunda Presbyterian church, officiating. Burial was in Oakwood cemetery.
