MRS. FLORENCE MACOMBER

The death of Mrs. Florence Macomber occurred at 8 o'clock Tuesday evening, Aug. 12, at her home at No. 49 Borden avenue, Perry. Her age was 69 years.

Florence Emily Hutchinson was born on a farm in the town of Castile in 1855, a daughter of James and Emily Hutchinson. She was the youngest of a family of seven children, none of whom survive. Her entire life has been spent in this vicinity. On Dec. 31, 1882, she was united in marriage to Miles Sharpsteen of Castile, who passed away in 1890. In November, 1892, she was married to Lewis A. Macomber, who died in February, 1915.

Surviving are four nephews, Elmer and Andrew French of Perry, Louie French of Raquette Lake, and Mortimer Hutchinson of Perry.

She also leaves three step-children: Mrs. A.R. Watrous of Perry, M.A. Macomber of Chicago and George S. Macomber of Buffalo.
