Mrs. Mariette K. Malturner

Mrs. Mariette K. Malturner died at the home of her son, Silas N. Malturner, on Court street, Thursday afternoon, September 6th, of old age, aged 89 years. The funeral was held at the house on Saturday, Rev. G. M. Gerrish and Rev. J. M Payson [both Universalist clergymen] conducting the ceremony. The burial was at Jerusalem Cemetery.

Mrs. Malturner was born in Jefferson county. She married John Malturner, who died about fifteen years ago. They moved from Somerville to what is known as the Malturner farm in Canton, fifty-four years ago, where Mrs. Malturner resided until she came to live with her son in the village. Three sons were born to Mr. and Mrs. Malturner: Perley, who died some fourteen years ago; A. J. Malturner, of Deadwood, South Dakota, and Silas N., of Canton.

For several years Mrs. Malturner has been in failing health, but she has been tenderly cared for and her last years have been made pleasant for her. Although death was daily expected, it came very suddenly and peacefully.
