## Mrs. Mariette K. Malterner

Mrs. Mariette K. Malterner died at the home of her son, Silas N. Malterner, on Court street, Thursday afternoon, September 6th, of old age, aged 89 years. The funeral was held at the house on Saturday, Rev. G. M. Gerrish and Rev. J. M Payson [both Universalist clergymen] conducting the ceremony. The burial was at Jerusalem Cemetery.
