ARTHUR MANCLOW DIES IN UTICA HOSPITAL

FORT PLAIN—Arthur H. Manclow, 77, of 104 Reid street died Wednesday in Utica Hospital where he had been a patient nine days. He had been ill six months.

The Rev. James Alcock, pastor of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, will officiate at the funeral service today at 2 p.m., at the Swartz funeral home. Burial will be in Fort Plain Cemetery in the spring.

Mr. Manclow, who was born in the Town of Minden Sept. 30, 1879, son of Joseph and Sarah Sneck Manclow, had always lived in this vicinity and was a carpenter engaged in construction work for many years. He was married Oct. 25, 1905, to Elva King and they had lived at the Reid street home 43 years. He was a member of Fort Plain lodge, Knights of Pythias, and the Universalist Church of the Messiah.

Survivors are his wife and four daughters: Miss Hazel Manclow at home; Mrs. Carmela Swartz and Mrs. Lucille Potter, Fort Plain; Mrs. Phyllis Mrozkowski, Tribes Hill; two sons, Howard of this village and Harvey of Schaghticoke; three brothers, Harold, Fort Plain, Irvin of Brookmans Corners and Earl of Sprakers; ten grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
