FORT PLAIN BUSINESSMAN DIES AT 65

FORT PLAIN—Alfred Marsh, 65, of River Street, Fort Plain, former owner and operator of Marsh's Market in the village, died yesterday at Albany Medical Center Hospital after a long illness.

He had been associated with the market for many years, then owned and operated the business from 1953 until 1963. A lifelong resident of Fort Plain, he was an honorary member of the Otsquago Fish and Game Club and a member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah.

Survivors include his wife, Vera Shults Marsh; a son, Alfred G. Marsh of Otsego; a daughter, Mrs. Marlene Salmons, Fort Lauderdale, Fla.; a brother, William Marsh; one sister, Mrs. Eva Francis, and one aunt, Mrs. Julia Kaiser, all of Fort Plain; also five grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
