DEATHS.

In this city, Jan. 18th, Mrs. Phebe Mayhew, aged 41. The death of this amiable and estimable woman is a great affliction. There are but few wives and mothers who would be missed so much as she will be. She was attentive to all her duties, and exemplary as a Christian. She has been, for many years, a member of the Orchard-street Church, and was always regular in her attendance at meeting and communion whenever her health would permit. She has left an aged mother, a brother, a sister, a husband, and a large family of children, to mourn her loss. During her sickness she was deprived of her reason, till within a few hours of her death. She then appeared perfectly calm and resigned. She was buried from the Orchard-street Church, which was crowded with sympathizing friends. A discourse was preached by Br. O. A. Skinner from the following words: "Let me die the death of the righteous."
