The funeral of Mrs. Margaret Mayton, whose death was briefly noticed in last evening's Observer, will be held from the Universalist Church to-morrow at 3 P.M., the Rev. J. D. Corby of Utica officiating. Burial in Oak Hill Cemetery. Mrs. Mayton was a daughter of the late Hon. and Mrs. Ezra Graves and was born here, where she has resided all her life, with the exception of four years spent in New York City. In 1871 she was united in marriage to William H. Mayton, whose death occurred three years later. Mrs. Mayton was a devoted member of the Universalist Society and was ever active in advancing the interests of that church. She was a valued member of Gen. Nicholas Herkimer Charter, D. A. R., and of Myrtle Chapter. O. E. S. Mrs. Mayton was one of Herkimer's best known and most highly-esteemed Christian women, and a large circle of friends will learn of her death with sincere regret. Her nearest surviving relatives are two brothers, Dr. George Graves of this village and Gen. John C. Graves of Buffalo.
