MRS. THOMAS McMANUS

Mrs. Thomas [Lina] McManus of Fly Creek died on Wednesday evening of this week at the Mary Imogene Bassett Hospital, following an illness of about six weeks. She was 77 years old.

Mrs. McManus was born in Exeter on August 23, 1873, daughter of William S. and Katherine (Fearn) Newkirk. She married Thomas McManus on February 21, 1894. They would have observed their 57th anniversary next week.

Survivors include her husband; one daughter, Mrs. Ambrose Campbell of Oneonta; one son, Harold McManus of Oneonta; three grandchildren, Mrs. Harold Felske and Grant T. Campbell, both of Oneonta, and Leland A. Campbell of Cooperstown.

Mr. and Mrs. McManus came to Fly Creek in 1943 from the town of Burlington, where they lived for 30 years.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Ingalls Funeral Home in Cooperstown, with the Rev. James Alcock, pastor of the Oneonta Universalist church, officiating. The body will be placed in the Ingalls vault here for burial in the family plot in the Schuyler Lake cemetery in the spring.
