Mrs. Miller was a member of Fort Plain Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, and the Study class. She was an attendant of the Universalist church.

Mrs. Miller is survived by a sister, Mrs. Martha Zoller Smith of Hallsville; six nephews, R. Z. Smith of Fort Plain, Claude Smith of Hallsville, Fred Smith of Lockport, Thomas Zoller, Abram Zoller [and] John I. Zoller of Little Falls; four nieces, Miss Eliza Zoller of Fort Plain, Mrs. Claude Smith of Hallsville, Miss Maude J. Zoller [and] Miss Zaida Zoller of Little Falls.

The funeral was held at the Universalist church on Sunday afternoon, Rev. R. H. Dix officiating. Interment was made in Mount Hope cemetery, Minden.
