George C. Miller died at the Binghamton State Hospital, Sunday night, May 31st, having been confined there for the past seven years, death being due to heart trouble. He was born March 10, 1851 in Otsego county and his home has always been in or near Schuyler Lake. He was the son of Henry and Katherine Casler Miller.

He married Cora Beadle in 1877. He was a cheesemaker by trade and made cheese in the Baker factory for many years. He leaves besides his wife, one daughter, Mrs. Ashley [Marie Elizabeth] Strong; one brother, Edwin, of Iliion, and several nieces and nephews.

His funeral, which was private, was held from the Miller-Strong home on Wednesday at 2 p.m., the Rev. W. H. Skeels [Universalist] officiating, with burial in Schuyler Lake cemetery.
