MEXICO, Sept. 22—Mrs. Elizabeth Markham, 83 years old, widow of the late David Minckler, died Monday morning after a long illness at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Albert Vaughn.

Deceased was born in Loraine, Jefferson county, in 1842, the daughter of William Markham and Beulah Tyler. When a small child her parents removed to Colosse and at the age of 13 years, she with her parents, came to live on what is known today as the David Minckler farm, northwest of the village. The past few years she has made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Vaughn. Two sons, Gates, of Geneseo, and Claud, of Schenectady, also survive her.
