ANDREW J. MOORE OF MIDDLEPORT IS DEAD AT 80 YEARS OF AGE Born on Creek Road North of Johnson Creek—Funeral Sunday

Andrew Jackson Moore, 80 years old, died Wednesday night at the home in State street after a few weeks' illness. He is survived by his widow, a son Lina J. Moore of Buffalo and three grand children, Helen M. Moore of Middleport, Margaret Gregg and Gladys Moore of Mariana, Arkansas, a nephew Rue Moore of Flint, Mich. and a niece, Mrs. Estella Bateman of Middleport.

The funeral will be held on Sunday afternoon at three o'clock with burial in Hartland Central cemetery. The Rev. Charles Clare Blauvelt [Universalist] will officiate.

Mr. Moore was born on the Creek road north of Johnson Creek in 1846 and has lived in this vicinity practically all his life. He was married to Margaret Adelaide Smith on February 20, 1868.

Mr. Moore has been in active business until 1923. For a period of years he was engaged in farming.

He also conducted a warehouse and bought produce. The latter part of his life he was engaged in selling farming implements.

During the administration of President Cleveland in 1886 he was appointed custom house officer at Niagara Falls. In 1890 he was appointed a deputy sheriff of Niagara county and moved to Lockport where he resided until 1892. For the last sixteen years he has lived at the home in State street. He held the high esteem of a large circle of friends in this community.
