Our whole village was shocked and saddened on Sunday last when news came of the death that morning at 5 o'clock of Mrs. Nora Sanford Moore, 52, wife of C. A. Moore, at the home of her oldest son, Lyle M. Moore, 434 Cortland Ave., Syracuse. Mrs. Moore was taken suddenly ill last February and went immediately to Hepburn hospital where she received treatment for a time going later to the home of her brother, Dr. M. J. Sanford at Suffern, N. Y., where she had the best medical attention and care. About three weeks ago she came to Syracuse, expecting after a short rest, to return to her home here; but her strength would not permit, and although it was known she was gradually failing, her condition was not considered critical for the time being, the end coming without warning only a half hour from the time a change for the worse was noticed. Funeral services will be held at the home of her son Lyle Wednesday at 2 P. M., with burial at Sennett, Cayuga county, Mrs. Moore's girlhood home. She is survived by her husband two sons, Lyle and Harold, the latter a student in the dental department of the university of Buffalo, one little grandson, David Moore of Syracuse, a sister, Mrs. H. S. Palmeter of Buffalo and one brother, Dr. M. J. Sanford of Suffern. Mrs. Moore had been a resident of this place since 1917, was very active in all social work of the town and leaves a host of friends to mourn her loss of one so suddenly snatched from our midst. She was a member of the Universalist Church of Canton and of the O. E. S. of this place; and was President of the Heuvelton University Extension Club and also of the Public Library Association. The sympathy of the community is extended to the bereaved family and friends.
