She is survived by her husband and three children, two sons and a daughter, Willis J. Moreland of this village, Lester Moreland of Muncie, Ind., and Miss Nora Moreland of Mottville.

Funeral services, conducted by Rev. A.[Arnold] S. Yantis of Auburn, were held at the family home at 2 p.m. to-day. Interment was made in the family plot in Lake View cemetery, Skaneateles.

Mrs. Moreland was cousin of Mrs. Dr. J. B. Kelsey of Marcellus, and Dr. Kelsey attended the funeral, Mrs. Kelsey not being able to go.
