Gunshot Wound Proves Fatal

Mrs. Geraldine E. Mosher, 39, of 1510 Brinckerhoff Ave., wife of Clifford E. Mosher, died July 3 in her home. Dr. Gerald C. Gant, coroner, said Mrs. Mosher died of self-inflicted gunshot wounds, and ruled suicide.

She was born in Utica. She attended local schools, and was graduated from Poland Central High School. She was married to Mr. Mosher in 1953 in Poland.

She was a member of Universalist-Unitarian Church of the Reconciliation.

Besides her husband she leaves her mother, Mrs. Esther M. Holiday Wilcott, in California; three daughters, Mrs. Michael (Linda) Kern, Utica; Misses Ruth and Barbara Mosher, both at home; a sister, Mrs. William (Marion) Clarke, Sepulveda, Calif.; two brothers, James B. Wilcott, Utica, Donald Wilcott, Redland, Calif.

A private memorial service will be Sunday in Universalist-Unitarian Church of the Reconciliation at the convenience of the family. There are no calling hours.
