Mrs. Samuel Munger

Mrs. Samuel Munger died last Tuesday morning at 7 o'clock at her home on Watkins avenue, after an illness of several weeks, resulting from a stroke of paralysis.

Mrs. Munger had been in comparatively good health until 14 weeks ago last Monday, when she suffered a stroke of paralysis. Since that time she has been confined to her bed, failing gradually until the end, which came peacefully and without pain.

Frances A. Anderson was a daughter of James and Lorinda Anderson and was born on the homestead farm on the Reservation in the Town of Castile on December 8th, 1847. She was the youngest of a family of 12 children—six sons and six daughters and was the last of the family.

On Sept. 26th, 1898, she was united in marriage to the late Samuel Munger and for several years afterward resided on his farm on the Silver Springs road, near the head of Silver Lake. Eight years ago they removed to Perry, having purchased a residence on Watkins avenue, and made that their home.

No children were born to them, but to her stepson, Earl V. Munger, she gave the same tender devotion and affection that is manifested to an own child, and in return received the affection that is bestowed on an own mother. Kindness ruled the home in her daily ministrations, and when affliction came she was given every care and faithful attention that human hands could offer by her stepson and his wife. She was a good neighbor and friend, quietly practicing the Golden Rule.

Mrs. Munger was a member of the Universalist Church of Perry.

The only near relatives by whom she is survived, in addition to her stepson above referred to, are Mrs. L.A. Macomber, a cousin, and W.A. Anderson, a nephew, of Castile.

Funeral services will be held at her late residence this afternoon at 2 o'clock, conducted by the Rev. H.A. Waite, officiating in the absence of Rev. Clara Morgan, who was previously called to LeRoy to conduct a funeral today.

Interment will be in Warsaw.
