She was a kind neighbor, a constant friend, a faithful wife and mother, and an ornament to society. She lived respected and died regretted; and the whole community will feel her loss. In her views of the Divine Providence, and religious tenets, she was a Universalist, although she always held that it is vastly more important *what we are than what we believe*. A very large concourse of relatives and friends assembled to pay their respects to her memory on the occasion of her funeral, in which services the writer was assisted by Elder Lamb (Baptist).
