Funeral Services Mapped for Frank D. Page, Middleport

Middleport—Funeral service[s] for Frank d. Page will be held at 2:30 p.m. tomorrow in the Richardson & Kneubel Funeral Home, 38 Main St. The Rev. George A. Gay, pastor of the Middleport Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be in Hartland Central Cemetery.

Mr. Page, owner of the Page trucking business in Middleport for many years, died Thursday (June 15, 1944) in his home in Main Street.

A resident of Middleport for more than 50 years, he had been connected with the trucking business for a long time. He was a member of Cataract Lodge, F&AM, of Middleport, the Buffalo Consistory, and Ishmalia Temple of the Shrine in Buffalo.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Lucy Ricker [Rieker] Page; one sister, Mrs. Millie Ford of Rochester; and one brother, Charles Page of Rochester. His son, Edward [Edwin] Page, died in Middleport this spring.
