MRS. MARYETT PALMER

At eleven o'clock on Monday evening last, January 12, Mrs. Maryett Palmer, wife of Charles J. Palmer of this place, died of pneumonia. The deceased, who was in feeble health for many years, was attacked with pneumonia on Thursday of last week. The attack was severe from the first but she lingered until Monday night.

Mrs. Palmer was born in Poundridge seventy-five years ago next March. Her maiden name was Schofield. She was married to Mr. Palmer at her home about 51 years ago. They had five children of whom three survive, namely, B. S. Palmer, of Carmel, H. C. Palmer, of Danbury, and Mrs. L. J. Quick, of Carmel.

Mr. Palmer was a farmer in Poundridge and about twenty-five years ago moved with his family to Croton Falls where they lived five years. From there they moved to this place and have lived here ever since.

Mrs. Palmer was a Universalist and Rev. Mrs. Crosby, of Danbury, a minister of that church, conducted the funeral services, which occurred at her late home yesterday afternoon (January 15) at one o'clock. Rev. E. W. Stone of the Baptist church and Rev. T. S. Bond of the M. E. church assisted. The burial was made in the family plot in Raymond Hill cemetery.
