William H. Parker died suddenly of heart failure, on Saturday evening of last week at his home on Church street. For a few days he had been suffering from grip and some heart difficulty but had been about town as usual during the day upon which his death occurred. He ate his supper and while sitting by the stove fell and expired before the physician could arrive. Coroner Burton was called and found that death resulted from the cause stated above.

Mr. Parker was in his forty-fourth year and had been a resident of Cooperstown for a number of years, where he had followed the business of a teamster. He is survived by his father, who resides in Garrattsville, his wife [Julia] and one son, Henry, who reside in Cooperstown, and by the following brothers and sisters: Leroy and Fred of Oneonta, David of Holmesville, Elijah E. of Rockdale, Alva of Garrattsville, Eugene of Ilion, Elisa of Hartwick, Mrs. Bert Bailey of Oneonta, Mrs. William Clark of Burlington, Mrs. Earl Clark and Mrs. Edward Alger of Garrattsville.

The funeral was held at his late residence Tuesday afternoon at 1 o'clock, the Rev. George Wilson Scudder [Universalist] officiating. The body was placed in the receiving vault at Lakewood cemetery.
