Lyndonville—The death of Flagler F. Parsels, 82, occurred some time during the night of April 11, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Harry Meland, 142 Roseland Avenue, Medina. His death came only a few hours after he had been the honor guest at a birthday party at the home of his son, Oakley Parsels, in Yates Center. He had retired upon arriving at the Meland home, and was found dead about 10 o'clock Wednesday morning.

Born in Addison, Steuben County, April 11, 1868, the son of Valentine and Lucinda Cornwell Parsels, the deceased had lived in the Town of Yates about forty-eight years, where he had engaged in farming until two years ago.
