The Funeral of Mrs. Ann M. Parsons

The funeral of Mrs. Ann M. Parsons, an old and respected resident of this city, took place from her late residence, No. 331 Washington street, this morning. Mrs. Parsons, who was the widow of the late N. A. Parsons, and formerly the wife of Mr. Andrew Oakes, who was at one time a Coroner of this County, had for the last thirty years or more, carried on the undertaking business in this city. She has been a resident of Brooklyn for many years, and was sixty-one years and eleven months old at the time of her decease. The funeral services were conducted yesterday by the Rev. Stephen H. Camp and the Rev. H. R. Nye, of the Universalist faith, of which church Mrs. Parsons has long been a member, but the burial did not take place until this morning, when the hearse, followed by carriages containing her immediate relatives, carried the remains to Greenwood.
