Death of Mrs. F. Maria Paul

Mrs. Frances Maria Paul, widow of Holland F. Paul, a former resident of Le Roy, died on Wednesday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Robert Stroots, in Boston Harbor, Mich., at the advanced age of 86 years.
