MISS EMILY PEARL DIES IN CLINTON

The death of Miss Emily Adele Pearl occurred at her home on College street, Clinton, Tuesday night.

Miss Pearl had been an invalid for over 22 years. She was born in Clinton, April 4, 1861, a daughter of Ralph and Esther Blair Pearl, and had lived in the house on Marvin street where she was born until two years ago, when her home was sold to the school. She was a member of the Universalist Church. She is survived by two sisters, Miss Ella M. Pearl and Miss Jennie A. Pearl of Clinton, and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral was held at the family home on College street at 2:30 on Friday. The Rev. [Clinton] Moulton of Dolgeville officiated. Burial was in Sunset Hill Cemetery.
