Death of an Old and Respected Resident of Newark

Newark, May 17.—Mrs. Milton S. Peer died at her home in Union street at 12:25 P.M. to-day from heart failure, following an illness of a year. She was one of the oldest and most highly respected residents of Newark and a consistent member of the Universalist Church for many years. Cornelia Stark Peer was born in Clinton county, April 10, 1831. She grew up to young womanhood in her native home, but came to Newark and married Milton S. Peer April 2, 1856.

The only immediate survivors are her husband, Milton S. Peer, and a daughter, Miss Maggie Peer. There are also three brothers, Norman Stark, of Clinton county, Luther Stark, living in Vermont, and William Stark, of Lyons; and two sisters, Mrs. Polly Dillon of Peru, N.Y., and Mrs. Ann Hadden of Ellenburg, N.Y.
