Dennis Phillips, of Bristol, was found dead about a mile east of town a week ago last Saturday. He had been to Honeoye to do some trading and a little later was found dead of heart disease near the roadside, his horse grazing near him.

The same day Vantyne E. Phillips, of Bristol, who had been poorly for some little time, died a few hours later. They were cousins, of the same age, 65 years, and both were married, died and were buried the same day. The double funeral was held from the Universalist church at Bristol on Tuesday. Both interments were in the Evergreen Cemetery here. Like David and Jonathan, they were "lovely and pleasant in their lives and in their deaths they were not divided."
